#### OLD TEXT

Article 8.1.2 of the IAME EURO SERIES Sporting Regulations.

*Tires for Free Practice, Non-Qualifying Practice and Warm Ups.*

The number of slick tires reserved for all Free Practice, NonQualifying Practice and Warm Ups is limited to 4 sets of new tires. The numbers of wet tires for all Free Practice, Non-Qualifying Practice and Warm Ups is not limited.

Article 21.1 of the IAME EURO SERIES Sporting Regulations.

*Suspending a practice, heat or race.*

(...)

The Race Director will announce a repair window time of 15 minutes. Once these 15 minutes window ends all mechanics/drivers must have completed any work on the kart and have the kart ready on the ground in their grid position. After this time has been completed, the Race Director will announce with the grid boards the time remaining for the restart (in any case, it will be no more than 5 minutes). ~~Karts must be ready to race on the ground when the one minute board is shown.~~ Failure to be ready to race means that kart/driver cannot restart the race.

#### NEW TEXT

Article 8.1.2 of the IAME EURO SERIES Sporting Regulations.

*Tires for Free Practice, Non-Qualifying Practice and Warm Ups.*

The number of slick tires reserved for all Free Practice, NonQualifying Practice and Warm Ups is limited to 4 sets of new tires. The numbers of wet tires for all Free Practice, Non-Qualifying Practice and Warm Ups is not limited.

**These tires will be shipped by RGMMC to each event the tires will be placed in a tyre-pool, raffled and handed out accordingly in the Servicing Park and they will be barcode scanned and controlled before each session and are compulsory to use.**

Article 21.1 of the IAME EURO SERIES Sporting Regulations.

*Suspending a practice, heat or race.*

The Race Director will announce a repair window time of 15 minutes.
